ANNOUNCEMENTS

- To avoid long waits during schedule pick-up days, we are requiring families to pay for any fees online through [AZ-In Touch Receipting](#) BEFORE you arrive to student pick up day. Lockers will be assigned closer to the start of school, and we are collecting parking permit applications. Once you are logged in:
 - The username is the student 10-digit matric number.
 - The password is the student's last name (case sensitive). DO NOT CHANGE YOUR PASSWORD.
 - Select "high school," and "Rincon High School."
 - There will be an additional choice for "University High School." **You must select University High School for the fees to appear and apply to your student.**
 - All students may pay for yearbooks, lockers, athletics, etc.
 - Testing fees (PSAT, SAT, ACT, etc.) will be covered in a future Weekly Penguin and at cohort nights by counseling staff.
- The "family folder" referenced in the last ParentLink message is the folder containing files pertinent to students and families, and can be access here: [UHS Family Info Folder](#). Apologies for the confusion! At this time the folder contains our current bell schedule, the parking permit application, and the laptop loaner agreement. As more information is added we will inform you, but in the meantime please feel free to browse. We will also post all items on the school website.

- When school starts, we are picking back up the student drop off/pick up routes that were in place just prior to the COVID closures. Please see the maps at the end of this newsletter, and let us know if you have any questions.

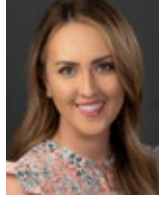

Student pick up days: July 26 – 30

All families are expected to complete the online registration process prior to the start of the school year. If you have not yet, you can complete it here: [University High School 2021-2022 registration](#). Next, our campus will be open for our students at the above dates to:

- Collect student schedules.
- Collect books.
- Pay fees.
- Arrange for any paperwork with district food services, transportation, etc.
- Take pictures for and collect a photo ID.
- Take yearbook pictures.
- Check out a laptop.

Pick-up is changing locations this year. It will begin in the **south gym**, continue to the **cafeteria**, continue to the **finance office**, and end at the service window at the **UHS administration office** to check out a laptop if you choose. The entire process should take about an hour and will be nearly entirely indoors to keep you cool. **SENIORS:** you may use either Inter-state or Silhouette for your senior pictures. Everyone else: fill out the information on the [Inter-state Studio website](#) to order your photos.

Laptop loaner agreement

Every student who wishes to check out a school laptop must complete the laptop loaner agreement form. You can either fill out a hard copy on student pickup days, or you can print and fill out the [agreement form](#) in our shared folder.

Schedule changes

All schedule changes must be completed either through the official paper form, or through the Google form link: [UHS 2021-2022 schedule change request](#). All requests are reviewed by UHS administration. If your request is approved you will be contacted and a new schedule provided, or you can see your revised schedule on [StudentVUE](#) and [ParentVUE](#). If

the request is not approved students will not be contacted, and they will follow their existing schedule. If parents do not have ParentVUE access they may call the school at 520.232.5902 to set up an account.

Sign up for REMIND

Remind is a quick, concise way to communicate pertinent info to the UHS community quickly. If you have not yet signed up for a REMIND code, instructions will be available on parent cohort meeting nights.

All students interested in a parking permit must submit an [application](#) for consideration. Students who receive a permit will be notified by telephone, and a list generated in the finance office to allow for payment and pickup of your permit. Due to the limited spaces available, parking permit approval is not guaranteed.

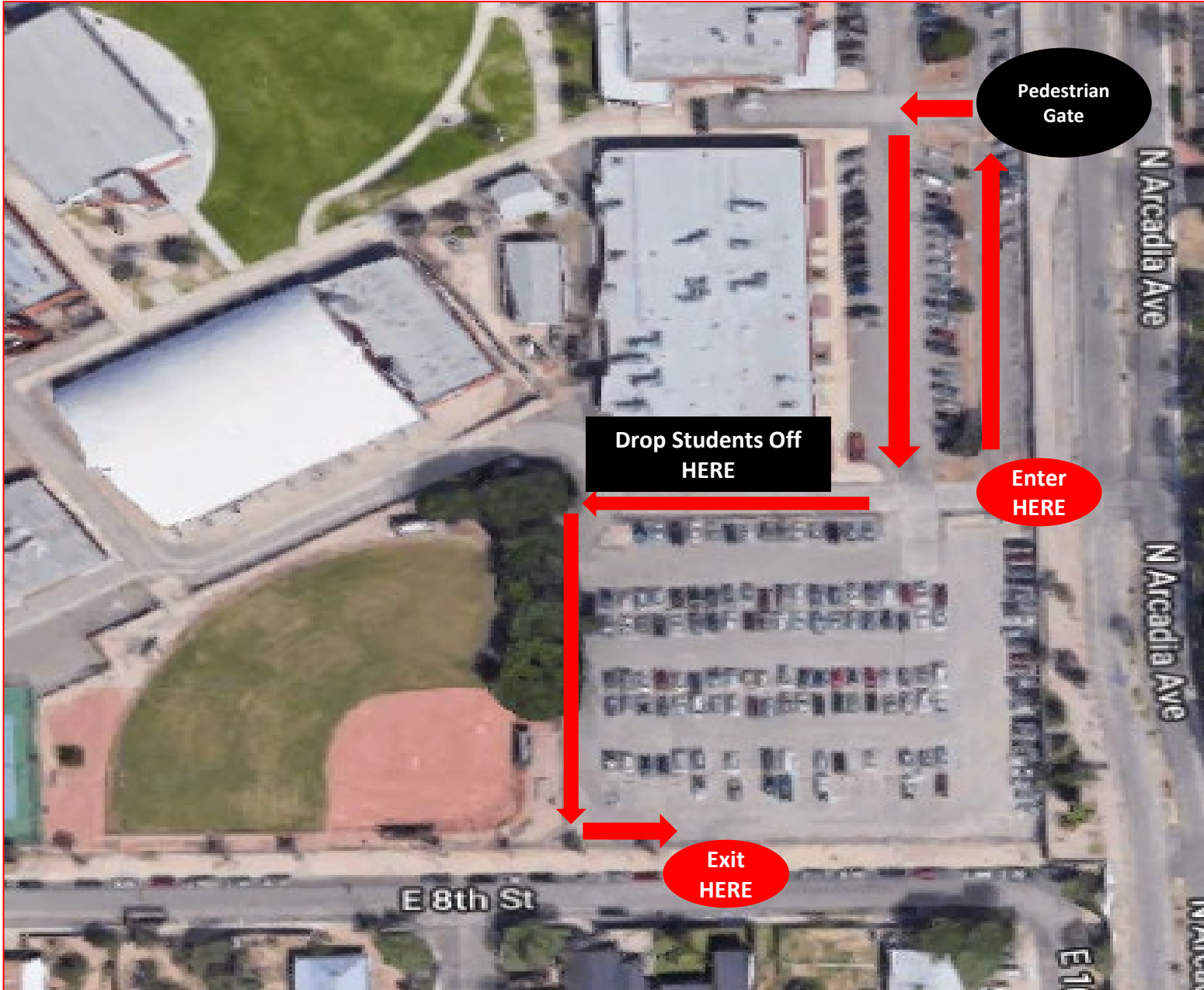
Mask wearing policy

As of July 1, 2021 Governor Ducey signed HB2898. Included in this budget bill is a provision that prohibits counties, cities, towns, schools, and school districts from requiring students or staff to wear a face-covering during school hours and on school property, effective July 1, 2021. Therefore, TUSD's face-covering requirement should no longer be enforced for students or employees. They should be considered optional.

Tucson Unified, along with federal, state, and local health officials, continue to recommend face coverings be worn by anyone who is not vaccinated. At the upcoming July 20th TUSD Governing Board meeting, the district's COVID-19 safety protocols for school re-entry will be discussed.

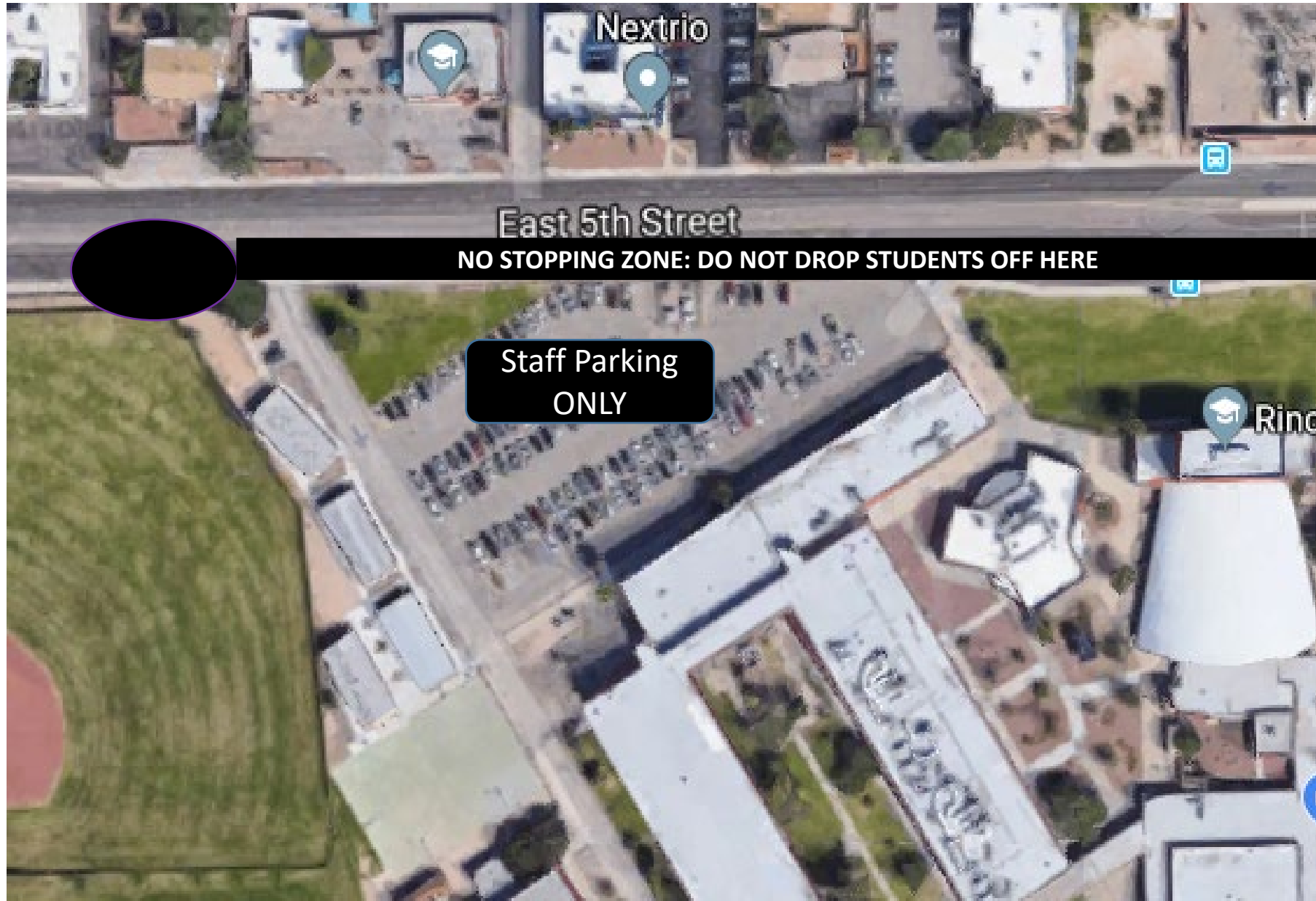
